We use cookies on this website. A cookie is a small piece of data that a website stores on your computer or mobile device. A cookie saves information. Cookies allow the website to remember your actions or preferences over time and prevent you from having to re-enter your data each time you visit the website.

Why do we use cookies?

- To optimize the website's performance
- To make website usage easier and increase user experience
- To measure if visitors can easily find the information they want to find on our website

What cookies do we use on this website?

Permanent cookies

By using permanent cookies we make sure that you do not have to re-enter your settings over and over again. We recognize the preferences that you selected earlier on our website. In this way, it saves you time and makes the website easier to use. Permanent cookies can be deleted via the settings of your browser.

Session cookies

Session cookies are activated during your visit and will be automatically deleted as soon as you close the browser. We remember which parts of our website you visited and adjust our services accordingly.

Google Analytics cookies

Google stores cookies on your computer or mobile device through our website, as part of the 'Analytics-service'. We use this service in order to track visitors' behavior and to get reports on the way in which visitors use our website. This allows us to improve our website subsequently. It is not about collecting personal data, but only tracks your behavior on the website.

Social media cookies

On our website you will find social media buttons to share our messages or webpages on social media. Think of 'shares' on Facebook or Twitter. These buttons use pieces of code from the social media platforms itself. Through these pieces of code cookies are placed. We cannot influence this. The social media platforms describe how they process the cookies containing your personal data in their privacy policies.

Tracking cookies from our own website

A tracking cookie is used when you visit a website within our network. This allows us to get insights in whether you used other websites within our network as well. The constructed profile is not related to your name, address, e-mail address etc., but only serves to personalize advertising based on your own profile to make them as relevant as possible.

Right to inspection, correction or deletion
